Supplementary Regulations.

ANNOUNCEMENT: The Thames Valley Trials Combine will organise a National trial Held under the British Women's & Girls Trials Championships Regulations, The National Sporting Code, Environmental Code and Standing Trials Regulations of the A.C.U. these Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions that may be issued.

ELIGIBILITY: Riders must hold a current ACU Trials Registration card or SACU Licence. Other riders must Produce a licence and Start permission confirming Insurance from their FMN.

CHILD PROTECTION: The Secretary of the Meeting is the point of contact (National sporting Code 6,14)

ENTRIES: Having entered the event, if you become a non-starter you must explain your absence to the promoting club. Failure to do so is a breach of the Rules. All entrants must show their club membership and ACU affiliation cards when signing on at the event and state the number on the entry form. **No Card = No Ride.**

ENTRY DETAILS: Open: on publication, Close: 2nd March 2012. Entry Fees: £20:00 + 2sae Cheques and Postal Orders to be made payable to: **Thames Valley Trials Combine.** And be sent to the Sec. of the Meeting.

Results will be within 30 minutes of last rider finishing, sent by post and also be posted and on the T.V.T.C. website: www.thamesvalleytrials.co.uk if you would prefer them emailed please put email address on entry form. Thank You.

COURSE: Hookwoods Trials Centre, West Horsley, Surrey. KT24 6EA. And will be entirely on Private Land and consist of a minimum of ten sections, with three routes as follows:

Route 1- Women's Championship Class and Girls A Championship Class. **Route 2-** Women's Intermediate Championship Class and Girls A Intermediate Championship and Girls B Championship Class. **Route 3-** Girls C Championship Class and Women's and Girls Newcomers. Number of laps and sections will be notified in final instructions. The first rider will start at 10:30am the rest as per Championship Regulations.

METHOD OF MARKING: Marking will be by TSR22A Stop Permitted

CLASSES: A; Women's Championship. B: Girls A Championship. C: Women's Intermediate Championship. D: Girls A Intermediate Championship. E: Girls B Championship. F: Girls C Championship. G: Women's Newcomers. H: Youth Newcomers.

AWARDS: Trophies for 1st 2nd and 3rd in each class will be given.

GENERAL: Assistants will be allowed, each rider may register one assistant to accompany them on the course and carry tools, provided he/she is not riding a machine. The assistant must be a minimum age of 18years. The rider and assistant must sign a declaration that the rider is responsible for all actions of their assistant. All machines Category 1 Motorcycles per NSC. Group A1 solos.
